As contained in General Order No. 5 in regards to the authorization for the Department of Ohio to pursue appropriate legal relief in the Court of Common Pleas of Clinton County, Ohio, to address the proposed sale of the GAR Ordnance Rifles presently situated in the Sugar Grove Cemetery in the City of Wilmington, Ohio.

The attorney representing the Department of Ohio in this action will be filing in the Clinton County Common Pleas Court asking for a Declaratory Judgment giving ownership of the two Civil War cannons to the Department of Ohio, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War and seeking a permanent injunction prohibiting Sugar Grove Cemetery from selling or removing the cannons or the war memorial.
