



**LINCOLN MEMBERSHIP MEDAL OF HONOR
FOR RECRUITMENT
DETERMINATION METHODOLOGY
(October 1, 2010)**

The Lincoln Membership Medal of Honor for Recruitment (Award) is for the enlistment of new hereditary members only. The Hereditary membership program is in force each year from **October 1st to September 30th.**

In order to be eligible for the Award, a Companion needs to recruit and recommend for hereditary membership (by signing on the application as the individual who makes the *referral* of the applicant) at least three new individuals whose applications are subsequently approved by the Registrar-in-Chief and recorded by the Recorder-in-Chief. The Recorder-in-Chief in consultation with the Senior Vice Commander-in-Chief determines who is eligible for the Award from the approved and recorded membership applications and appraises the Chancellor-in-Chief and Commander-in-Chief accordingly.

Any Companion who secures three new Hereditary Companions will receive a *Lincoln Membership Medal of Honor* and a *Lincoln MOLLUS Certificate of Appreciation* (signed by the Chancellor-in-Chief and Commander-in-Chief) from the Commander-in-Chief. The award is presented to the qualifying Companion(s) during a National Congress.
