The Following Committee Assignments and Committee taskings are hereby ordered:

1. The creation of a CinC appointed committee, which is tasked to write a job description for a contracted position to be called "The Development Officer." This committee will be chaired by National Treasurer David McReynolds with PCinC Donald Darby, Brothers Fred Lynch, and Kent Melcher as members. The committee is to provide its recommended wording for the new job description to the CofA at the Gettysburg CofA meeting.
2. The Communications and Technology Committee is hereby tasked to design a digital survey for the purpose of determining the current number of veterans of the United States Armed Services, to conduct that survey, and report its results to the CofA no later than the Gettysburg CofA meeting.
3. The P&P Committee is also hereby tasked to determine and submit to the CofA, language appropriate, for use on the membership application forms 3 and 60, which will provide a method for identifying those applicants who are currently or have in the past served in the United States Armed Forces. This task is to be accomplished as part of the ongoing review and revision of forms 3 and 60.
