

Attachment to Fund Request, Centennial Camp 100, Dept. of CO & WY, SUVCW

1. Purpose of funds: To build a suitable memorial to the members of the G.A.R. and other Civil War veterans buried at Section 27, Riverside Cemetery, Denver, CO. There are more Civil War veterans buried at Riverside than in all other cemeteries in Colorado – more than 1,200, including three Medal of Honor recipients. The project will also honor veterans of all America's wars. Section 27 of the cemetery was purchased by the G.A.R. in the 1880s although veterans of other wars are also buried there. The project concept includes a raised plaza surrounding an existing flagpole connected to the road by a brick walkway and a stand alone monument to the G.A.R. Members of the public may purchase engraved bricks for the walkway to memorialize their ancestor's service. Currently, there is nothing in Section 27 to indicate its association with the G.A.R. (See attached drawing for plaza & walkway design. Monument design still pending.)

2. Riverside Cemetery is owned by the Fairmount Cemetery Co., 430 S. Quebec St., Denver, CO 80247. Section 27 was purchased by the combined GAR Posts in Denver, CO in the 1880s. We have found nothing to indicate that they sold or bargained away their title so ownership of section 27 probably falls under the Deed of Conveyance to the SUVCW.

3. Current and planned fund-raising efforts:

Sale of bricks – approx. \$4600 raised to date.

Misc. contributions \$354 to date.

Solicitation of veteran and patriotic groups (Am. Legion, VFW, DAR, etc.) – planned (est. \$500).

Civil War book raffle – on-going. \$ 120 raised to date.

SUVCW Charitable Fund Grant – \$1000.

Solicitation of businesses for sponsorship – planned (est. \$500).

Grant requests of other charities/foundations are stymied by our 501(c)(4) tax designation.

4. Work to be done and associated costs:

Plaza Section - \$6019 (2011 est. by Blue Ribbon Concrete). The plaza section will be a raised platform 20" in diameter within a retaining wall approximately 16" high with a ramp at the Western end. The platform will be surrounded by a concrete walkway. Labor & materials include: 4" slab on grade w/wire & fibermesh (780sf); 24" thickened edge w/#4 rebar monolithic w platform slab (62 lf); Stamp boarder and sides (62 lf) & 3 ea concrete steps .

Memorial Walkway Section - \$1000.00 (2011 est.). The walkway section will be a walkway 47" in length and 6" wide made of standard 4x8" brick pavers with a 1' edging on each side. Engraved bricks purchased by donors will be of a higher quality. Estimate assumes 35 engraved bricks and 925 plain pavers. Actual installation of the walkway will be done by Americorps volunteers.

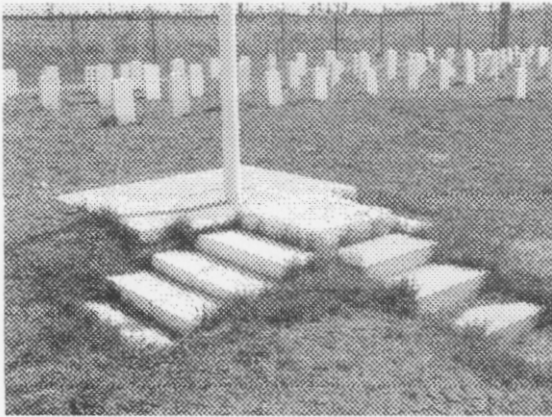
Monument Section - \$2000 (est.). The Monument section design is still under consideration but will be either an engraved monumental stone, bronze plaque or laser etched slab. The stand alone monument will dedicate the cemetery section to the GAR. The \$2000 figure is minimum estimate depending on the final design.

The project budget includes a contingency of \$300 to cover price variances and miscellaneous costs.

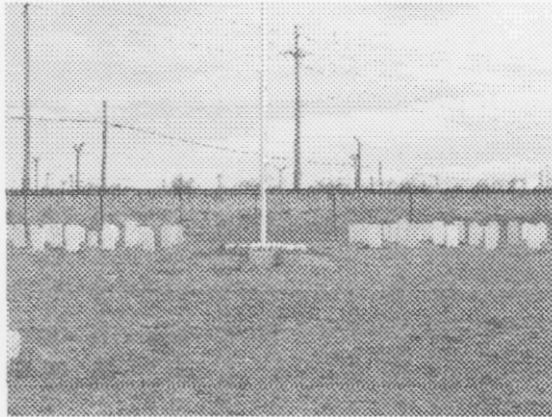
5. Brother Cliff Dougal (deceased) designed the original concept for this project. He was at the time Manager of Riverside Cemetery. Brother Craig Ayler, PCC is the present project officer. He refined the design which was approved by the Camp in regular session. He had engineering drawings made by a certified engineer and negotiated with the contractors.

6. Blue Ribbon Concrete. Inc. is the prime contractor. They have been in business many years and are bonded & insured. Americorps will install the bricks for the walkway. Vendor for the monument has not been selected.

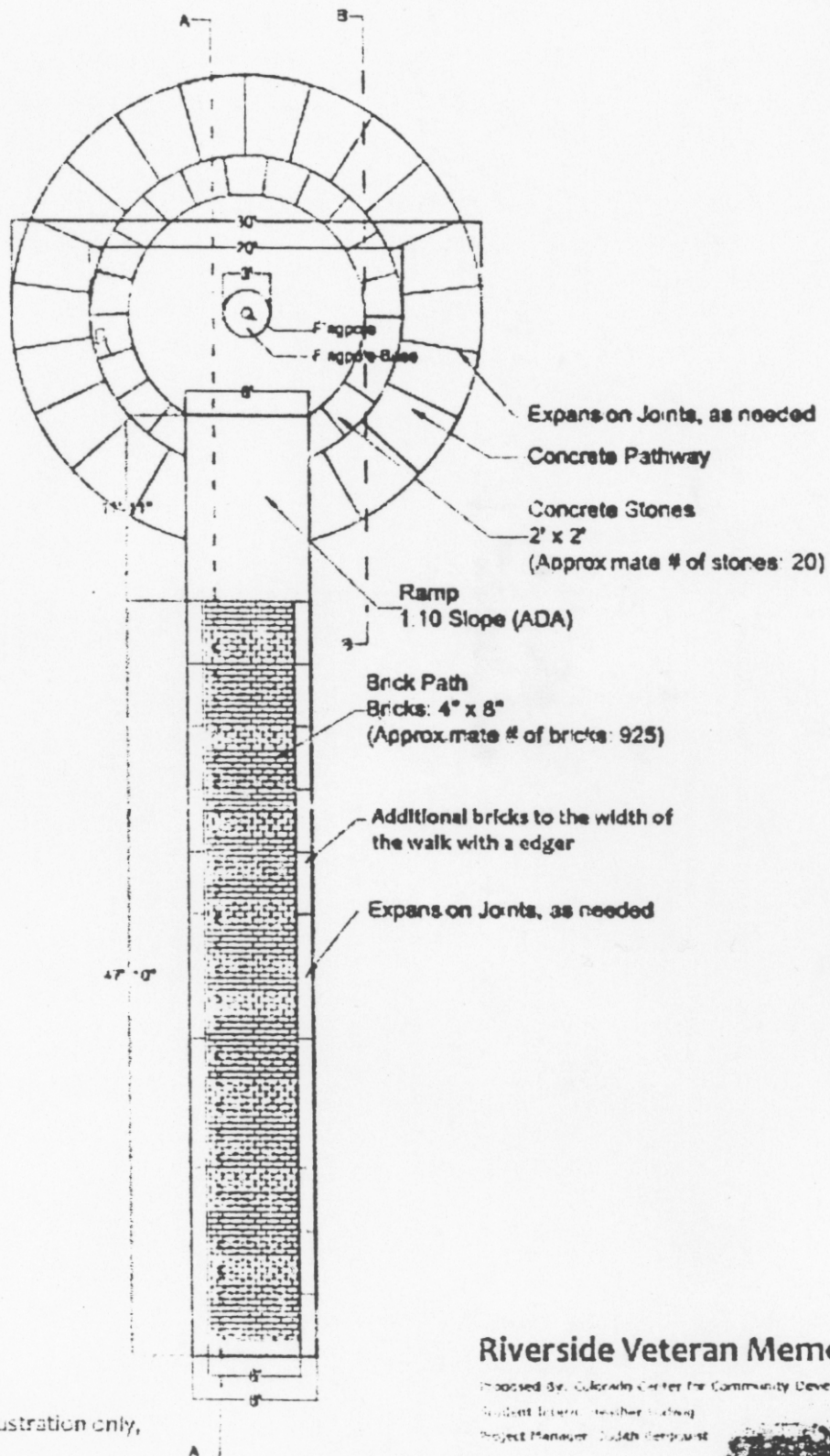

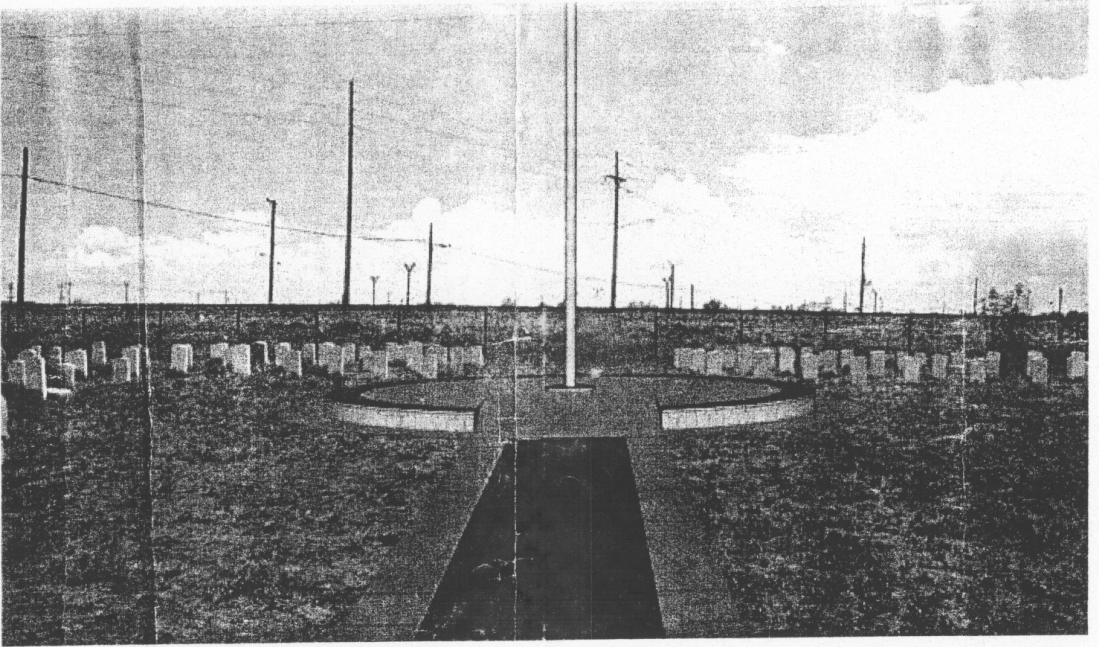

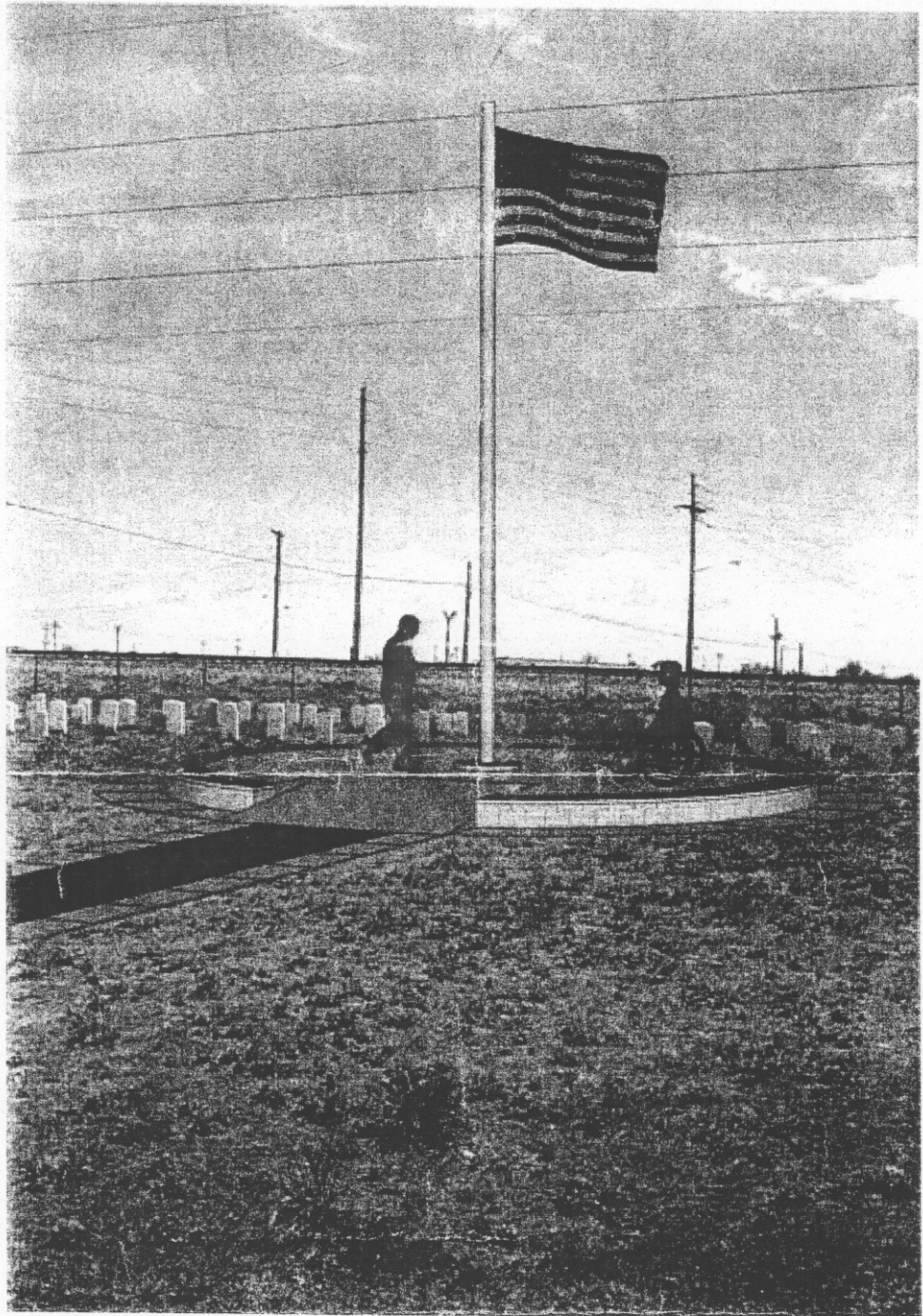

This cemetery contains the resting place of more Civil war veterans than all other cemeteries in Colorado including three recipients of the Medal of Honor.
