NO MORE TO GIVE

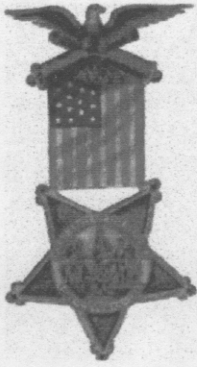

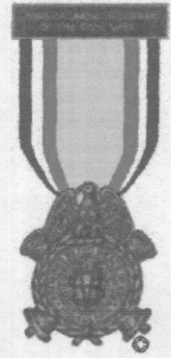

Dear Brother Petrovic,

Enclosed you will find a memorials grant request for the Minnesota State Monument of the monument project at Allatoona Pass, Georgia. You already have grant requests I prepared some time ago for the Wisconsin and Ohio monuments. I did not expect to have to file for Minnesota, but have just been informed that I should do so. As you may recall, the SUVCW helped Mark Willard raise a monument on the Allatoona battlefield to his state of Iowa and also helped me to raise one to my state of Illinois. Both were dedicated in 2008. How rare it is to be able to honor our forebears with new monuments on a pristine battlefield site.

Brother Shane Peterson, a CC in Minnesota, put in last year for a SUVCW monuments grant for the Minnesota monument, and it was graciously granted and deposited with the Etowah Valley Historical Society. We have a Minnesota patriot, Don Peterson, who gave \$5,000 for this monument as matching funds on the condition that we, meaning Shane and myself, raise the rest. We are racing the confederates to get all Federal state monuments completed before they complete theirs, and hopefully all in place for the sesquicentennial.


In order to order the stone and get it carved and installed by the battle anniversary date October 2nd of this year, we had to go ahead and order now. Even though I am an Illinois man I wanted to help our brothers out, so I gave \$3,000 to this project. I assured Don Peterson that Shane could raise a few more hundred and we had hope of another \$500 grant from the SUV this year, so he did not wait until we had all our funds before he contributed his \$5,000 matching funds. The monument costs \$10,000 and as of last month we had \$9,100 with Mr. Peterson's money, so we instructed Etowah Valley Historical Society to forward the first half of the monument's cost to Magnolia Monument Company to get the ball rolling for this October.

Brother Shane is still working to raise what he can. I pledged that I would contribute whatever shortfall he had. I am not a wealthy man, but I did start receiving Social Security in January which allowed me to make my contribution. Brother Shane informs me that his camp in Minnesota voted against applying to you again for the Minnesota monument as the camp wanted to do another project. As authorized Federal coordinator for this project it therefore falls to me to make the enclosed grant request. This is all a long explanation of why this request is coming from me and not CC Shane Peterson as last year. I pray that you will grant it, as it will be difficult for me to contribute another large amount.

At an SUV function last weekend Department of Georgia and South Carolina Commander Eric Peterson, a Wisconsin man, mentioned to me that it was his understanding that only a few grant requests for monuments had been made so far this year. If so, I take it that these may be the ones I filed for Wisconsin and Ohio. He encouraged me to write to you and ask if \$500 per project is the absolute ceiling for grants. I replied that I thought that this was the regulation, but he added that if funds were not applied for they might be available for on-going projects such as Wisconsin and Ohio, which states thus far have not made a great response to my appeals.

I do not mean to sound presumptuous, but if Commander Peterson is correct, I am coming to you with my Union kepi in hand asking that you help us with Minnesota so that we can complete it this year as planned, and that if there are any other funds available that it be directed to this most worthy project. Receipt from Etowah Valley Historical Society will, of course, be provided and granted funds sent through Elias Moon #2 CC Ed Hackney at the address on the application.
