

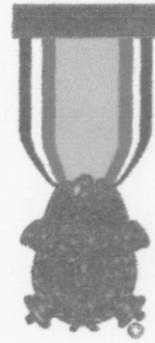

The 1st request was #2008-09-14 and you received a grant of \$500.00. The 2nd request was #2009-10-5 and you received a grant of \$500.00. You should not have received this grant because you already received one. The 3rd request was #2011-12-10 and the grant was denied. This is the 4th request #2012-2013-10 and we have denied this grant. If we receive another request for a grant for the Wisconsin Monument from you we will be forced to contact the CoFA and tell them you refuse to follow the guide lines and ask them what course of action we should take.
