

Photo record of pin and glue repair. Minor masonry repair is not included in OM quote. After the epoxy has set, Baker Camp volunteers will seal cracks and voids, clean the monument top to bottom. We will then apply a fresh coat of white paint. There are letters that are missing on the East side of the monument which we are still researching as to what they were before they were removed by vandalism. Baker Camp volunteers will also perform routine grounds keeping work.
