The design work is being donated. Funds will be required to pay for any cost not donated to shape four granite tablets and sand blast into them the names of the 186 men from Barre City and Barre Town who joined the armed forces to fight for the Union during the Civil War. (Note: The horizontal view drawing shows five tablets but to accomodate a path there will be two tablets on either side of the path.)

WHO EVALUATED THE NEED FOR THE WORK, AND WHAT ARE THEIR QUALIFICATIONS? Camp members determined that there is no monument to recognize and preserve the names and memories of the local men who volunteered to save the Union.

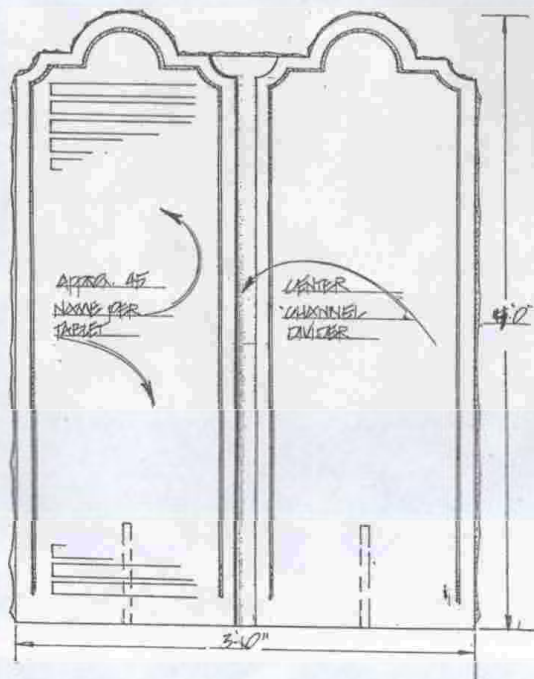
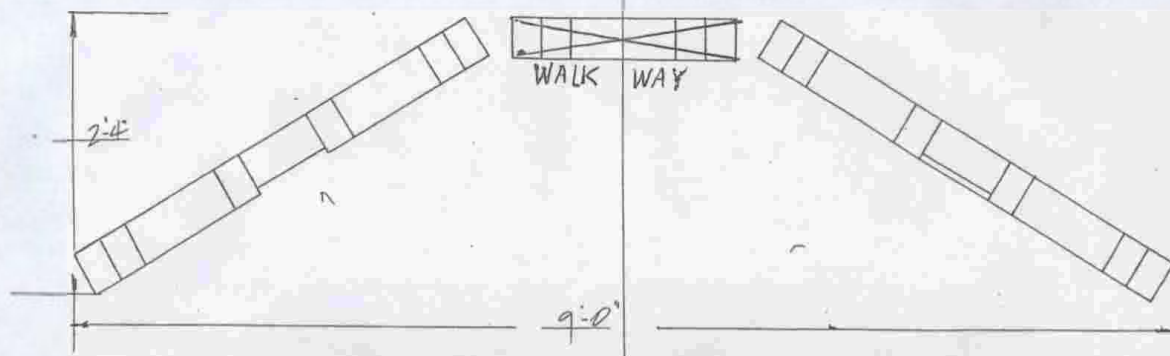

2. UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC SERVICE FROM CITY HALL AND REPLACE WOOD FOMER POLE WITH ELECTRIC REESTAL-METER BREAKER BOX AND OUTLETS FOR 200 AMP SERVICE. EXTEND SERVICE FROM ELECTRIC REESTAL TO GAZEBO. DRAFTING SIGNALS LIGHTS FOR MEMORIAL SCULPTURE AND FLAG POLE LOCATE AND PRELIMINARY HANG HOLE OUTLETS FOR DECORATIVE TREE LIGHTS INCLUDING ELKS CLUB MEMORIAL SPRUCE TREE. 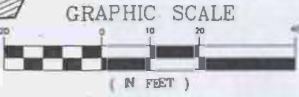
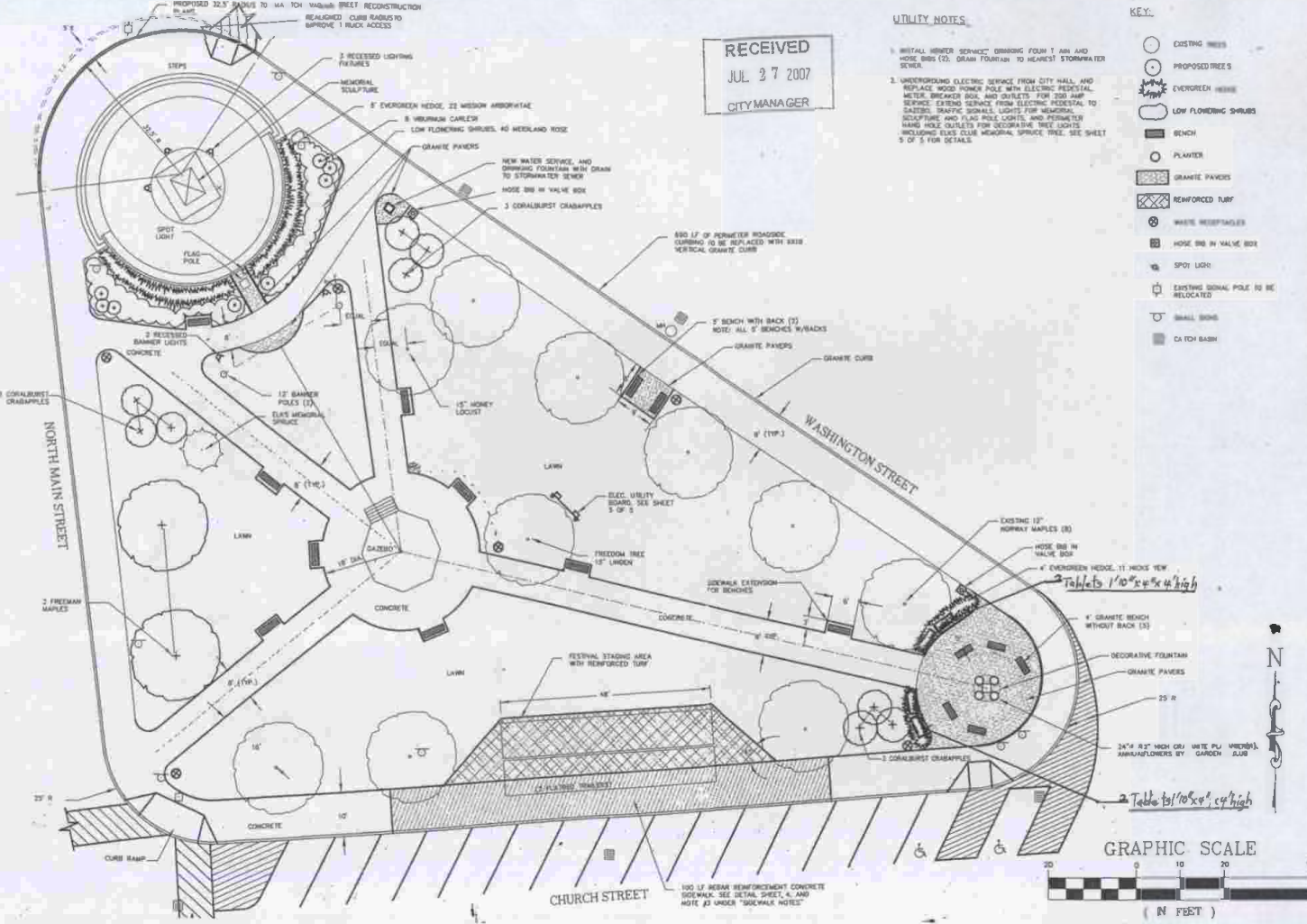
