DESCRIBE THE WORK THE GRANT IS NEEDED FOR (Be specific, use continuation sheet if needed)

Erection of Scaffolding around entire Monument. Work included removal of patina from soldier figure, atop the monument. Protective coating applied after patina removal. Granite (stones) in the base cleaned by sandblasting. Lead and granite mortar joints repaired. Cannon Treatment-cleaned (and graffiti removal) and protective coating applied. Graffiti removal on two of four Battle names inscribed on base. Soldiers' rifle strap and sword had been previously vandalized and required recasting of both. One bronze plaque on the base had been stolen and needed remaking.

This project began in 2016 and completed in the fall of 2017.
