Thank you for your inquiry into B&W manufacturing a Civil War Memorial Monument. The following describes the manufacturing of the requested monument, including pricing for the project.

The monument will be manufactured out of 14ga sheet steel, laser cut, broke and powder coated to agreed upon colors. The monument will stand approximately 6' tall, have laser cut lettering on each side panel. There will be a secondary panel powder coated gold on the inside of each panel to allow the letters to stand out. There will be a flag holder on the top of the monument as well.

The total project will cost \$2500.00 for all material, labor, paint and engineering.

Upon agreement of final design, B&W will begin the process of manufacturing the monument. At the time of agreement, we will also give and estimated completion date.
