Ness ~ Seventh Kansas Cavalry ~ Died August 22, 1864 ~ Abbeville, Mississippi ~ In 1878, the Kansas Legislature named Ness County in his honor. This statue is in Memory of Noah Ness and all the brave men who have fought to keep this country free. ~ Dedicated June 2000 ~ Sculptor: Harold T. Holden"
