Trail, Endured ~ The Hardships Of Frontier ~ Life, And Blazed The Path ~ Of
Civilization For ~ Posterity”

“Erected by ~ Women’s Kansas Day Club, ~ Daughters ~ of the American Revolution, ~
Women’s Relief Corps, ~ Kansas Federation of Women’s Clubs, ~ Woman’s ~ Christian
Temperance Union”

“Monument Erected May 21, 1912(?)”

“Pawnee Rock, Given to the State of Kansas by Benj. P. Unruh, in the year 1908”
