I am doing some volunteer research for the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War (SOUVCW) which is the successor organization to the Grand Army of the Republic (GAR). SOUVCW is attempting to locate and catalogue all GAR monuments and Civil War cannons. As I live in Spokane, I have volunteered to attempt to "inventory" the eastern part of Washington state.

The December 1916 edition of the *Spokesman-Review* newspaper reported that Pomeroy GAR had received two cannons that had been used in the Civil War. Can you tell me if those cannons still exist and where they might be located? Are there any GAR monuments located in Pomeroy or in local cemeteries?
