On the South side is a base with raised letters of dates 1861 - 1865. Above this is the plaque of second dedication in 2000 which states by VFW Post 2351 and Garfield Pioneer Association; For WW I and II Korean, Vietnam and all others. And a rooster of Deceased CW GAR Post Comrades with 6 names. Across this facing stone surface is a slight diagonal crack. At the top is the GAR emblem. The East side lists a roster of 24 ex Union soldiers living in Garfield County but non members of the Post. The North side shows the names of 40 members of McDowell Post #22 of GAR Department of Washington and Alaska. The West side lists a roster of soldiers buried in Garfield County but non-members. 23 names are on this list. These lists were of course identified as of the time of the original dedication in 1904. The Courthouse and monument are part of the NRHPlaces, thus more information and pictures are available by a search of Garfield County, WA and GAR monument. The Statue schulpture protraying Garfield County pioneer farmer and Union CW veteran John Mitchell was built by a Pomeroy school graduate Randy Bowen of the H.S. class of 1976. His company is Bowen Designs.
