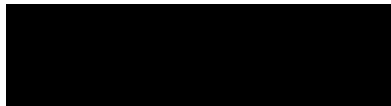

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Volunteers tidy up, replace worn headstones at Capitol Hill cemetery

About a mile north of the busy Broadway business district is the final resting place of more than 220 Civil War veterans who settled here after the war, their stories largely forgotten by all but a few descendants, neighbors and history buffs.

Tucked away in the middle of a Capitol Hill neighborhood, the cemetery is easy to miss. A sign bearing its name — Grand Army of the Republic — is barely noticeable, the gravestones weathered by wind and rain and damaged by vandals.

Several years ago, the Seattle City Council proposed turning the surrounding park property into an off-leash area for dogs — a development that galvanized neighbors and others to save the old cemetery, spreading the word about its history, garnering grant money from the city and spending one Saturday a month raking, weeding, clipping and irrigating.

Yesterday the group — FGAR, for Friends of the Grand Army of the Republic — and their supporters came together to replace 20 headstones that had been worn away or stolen. They hope eventually to replace 100.

"Rather than having the memories of these soldiers wiped away completely, we wanted to replace the gravestones to honor what these men went through," said Lee Corbin of Graham, Pierce County, a member of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War.

The group, made up of direct descendants of Civil War veterans, and FGAR enlisted the help of a local genealogist to find out who is buried at the site so their headstones can be replaced.

"We've spent the last five years trying to restore the park and give it some dignity," said Tom Easthope, FGAR'S treasurer.

Among those buried at the GAR Cemetery is Michael LaDuke, who was a member of Company A of the 16th New York Volunteer Infantry and, according to his great-great granddaughter, Lynn Sharp of Granite Falls, a prisoner of war in Vicksburg, Miss.

"We're preserving our history," Sharp said, taking a break from pulling weeds.

Union soldiers created the Grand Army of the Republic as a national fraternal organization for Civil War veterans. When members here in Washington began to die, the group built the 2.5-acre cemetery and later gave surrounding land to the city.

The site is at 12th Avenue East and East Howe Street, across the street from Lakeview Cemetery.

Dewey Potter, a Seattle Parks and Recreation spokeswoman, said FGAR's dedication to the cemetery has kept the area from falling into disrepair, since the city doesn't actually own the cemetery, just the land around it.

"Because of the limitations of staff, we couldn't have kept the cemetery looking the way it does without volunteer groups, which contributed 80,000 hours last year," she said. "At \$15 an hour that adds up to \$1.2 million for area trails and parks like this one."

For Sharp it's especially comforting to know that one of the 100 headstones to be replaced will be that of LaDuke, who moved to Washington after the war, according to Sharp.

"We're doing this for the future generations," Sharp said. "So they know where they come from and they can look up information about their ancestors themselves."

PREFACE

The GAR Cemetery in Seattle, Washington was platted in 1896. It is located on the north and of Capital Hill in Seattle. The cemetery land is covered with grass, maple and oak trees and is fenced by tall shrubbery, which does not make it easily visible from the street. The cemetery is maintained by the Seattle Parks Department.

In the center of the oldest part of the cemetery is a pylon monument, placed by the Woman's Relief Corps. On the face of the monument is the phrase "In memory of our Heroes 1861-1865". On the three remaining sides of the monument at the base are rectangles showing crossed swords, cannons and muskets. There is a flag pole next to the monument.

This Civil War cemetery has 526 graves, mainly of Union and Confederate veterans and their wives. There are both Army and Navy veterans buried there. The majority of veteran's graves are of Union military units. There are twenty-five states represented in this cemetery.

At the conclusion of the Civil War, many of the veterans came west alone or with their families, seeking adventure or a new life in what is now the state of Washington. 1889 is Washington's Centennial year. In the year 1889, this area was a land of opportunity, with fertile soil, lush evergreen forests, tall mountains, rivers, lakes and Puget Sound, a western boundary of the Pacific Ocean and a Northern boundary with Canada. Seattle became a busy seaport on Puget Sound and developed large fishing and lumbering businesses. People who came to Seattle found that it was an ideal location for many successful business enterprises and a beautiful environment in which to live. Many descendants of the Civil War veterans buried in this cemetery still live in Seattle.

The original transcription of all the names on the gravestones in this cemetery was done in 1979 by Helen Chase Keliehor with Children of the American Revolution groups. Helen Chase Keliehor was President of the C.A.R. groups in the State Of Washington and carried out this project of recording the G.A.R. cemetery data with the young people of C.A.R. who learned valuable lessons in history, regard for our veterans, patriotism and the actual service performed in recording the data. Helen Chaise Keliehor has given outstanding service to NN.S.D.A.R and C.A.R. and is presently the Regent of the Elizabeth Bixby Chapter, N.S.D.A.R. in Seattle, Washington.

Cemetery mapping was done in April, 1989 by Eileen E. Boyce Stich Joan E. Zorn Strand, members of Elizabeth Bixby Chapter, N.S.D.A.R. in Seattle, Washington. The map and the lists of graves by row and number show the location of the graves of all but 18 people listed in the 1979 transcription. In the years between 1979 mid 1989, 18 gravestones have been discovered to be missing. This is noted by the names of those people in the list. There are also six veteran's graves marked "Unknown". Variations in the spelling of a few last names are noted as spelled the same as on the gravestone.

It is possible that there are other Veterans buried in this cemetery whose gravestones were missing before 1979, but the cemetery was not recorded before that time. The remaining stones are showing varying amounts of deterioration and are becoming increasingly difficult to read. Elizabeth Bixby Chapter, N.S.D.A.R. felt that it was most important to have a published record of the information from this cemetery for present and future generations as well as to honor the Civil War veterans buried in this Grand Army of the Republic Cemetery.

1991 REVISION OF THE G.A.R. CEMETERY BOOK

In the spring of 1991, I received a phone call from Bob Hay, President of the Scottish Military Association and a member of the S.A.R. He told me that the Scottish Military Association was hoping to work with the Seattle Parks Department in their "Adopt-A-Park" plan by adopting and keeping up the maintenance of the G.A.R. Cemetery in Seattle and to bring back the patriotic and memorial services that were once held annually in the G.A.R. Cemetery. Bob Hay had also discovered a short history of the Cemetery, platting plans, varied pieces of correspondence regarding the maintenance of the Cemetery, and the old Cemetery plot assignment list which was found in the offices of the Lakeview Cemetery.

The 1989 cemetery book had been compiled by using a 1970s listing from the gravestones with work done by Helen Keliehor of Elizabeth Bixby Chapter, NSDAR and C.A.R. members. In 1989, using this work as a basis for compilation, members of Elizabeth Bixby Chapter, NSDAR transcribed the information from each gravestone and mapped the cemetery from Helen Keliehor's papers in addition to the gravestones still present in the Cemetery. At that time, though a number of sources were contacted, there was no evidence of a plot list. When the plot list was found in 1991, it was evident that the list gave a more complete roster of those buried in the Cemetery, therefore a revision of the 1989 Cemetery book was essential to preserve a more complete record and make corrections in the names from eroding gravestones and also in finding out how many gravestones were missing from the Cemetery.

The entire 1989 Cemetery book has been re-written with new grave numbers and plot numbers from the old plot list, as well as the addition of the short history of the Cemetery and some data on names of Veterans and their wives gathered from assorted early Polk Seattle City Directories.

Investigation is still going on regarding an earlier planting of the Abraham Lincoln oak tree at the Cemetery which was originally sent from Abraham Lincoln's birthplace in Kentucky. There will be a continuing search for more old documents regarding the Cemetery. Hopefully, the Veterans' Administration will be replacing the missing gravestones of Civil War veterans.

It is of the greatest importance that the G.A.R. Cemetery be maintained, kept in good order with all records available kept in public repositories. The Scottish Military Association is to be commended for their efforts in this matter so that this generation and future generations may know about and pay honor to these Veterans of the Civil War.

History of the G.A.R. Cemetery

About 1895, five Grand Army of the Republic posts in Seattle established this cemetery for the heroes of 1861 - 65 (the Civil War) and maintained it until 1922. They then hired the neighboring Lakeview Cemetery Association, Inc. to take care of the property at their expense, but the financial and maintenance burden was too great for the diminishing numbers of old veterans so they placed their problem before the Seattle City Council.

By purchase and condemnations, a sympathetic Council acquired the property surrounding the gravesites, the gravesites being deeded to the G.A.R. Stevens Post No. 1, and turned it over to the Park Department for "park purposes" together with maintenance of the entire area. The scattered gravesites were relocated to a central grouping and the upright headstones were imbedded in concrete flush with the lawn, a sprinkling system installed, trees and shrubs planted, including a hedge enclosing the gravesites. Maintenance became an increasing problem, owing to the legal complications in spending funds on property not legally owned by the city, so caretaking became minimal.

An attempt was made in 1939 to create a W.P.A. Improvement project including a service building and perimeter fence, but was unsuccessful. During World War II, the Coast Artillery was permitted to emplace a searchlight with power plant and crew quarters in the park. Then came a period of abuse and dumping of refuse and garbage and the playing of ball games across the gravesites as well as "lawns": shrubs and trees were knocked down or damaged.

Police and maintenance crews were ineffective, so the trustees of the Stevens Post, G.A.R. attempted a solution by hiring a firm (Martin Pick Co.) to assist in maintenance, but in 1955 again sought help from the City Council. The request was tabled for study, including an attempt to transfer maintenance and control to the Federal Cemetery system, but the request was lost in red tape. In 1960 there was an attempt to remove either the gravesites or the maintenance to the Fort Lawton facility. No action.

The Lakeview Cemetery Association, Inc. corresponded with Senator Warren G. Magnuson about this matter and he contacted both the Veterans Administration and Department of the Army. The Veterans Administration was only authorized to maintain cemeteries in connection with its own installations. The Department of the Army Quartermaster General's Office replied that they could not provide funds for maintenance, but by a 1948 law they could furnish appropriate headstones for the unmarked graves of Civil War Veterans. This correspondence was in 1960.

ADDENDUM FROM 1955 LIST OF GRAVESTONES WITH INSCRIBED DATES OF DEATH

On June 5, 1955, Martha (Morrison) Shellabarger of Seattle, WA copied the gravestones in the G.A.R. Cemetery that had dates of death inscribed on them. This was done to help research obituaries of the veterans in the local newspapers. The gravestones without death dates were not copied. This list is in typed copy at the Seattle Public Library Genealogy Department. Since this is the earliest manuscript of names from this cemetery, it was checked against the 1979 and 1898 transcriptions used in this publication. The following additional information was found in the 1955 copy:

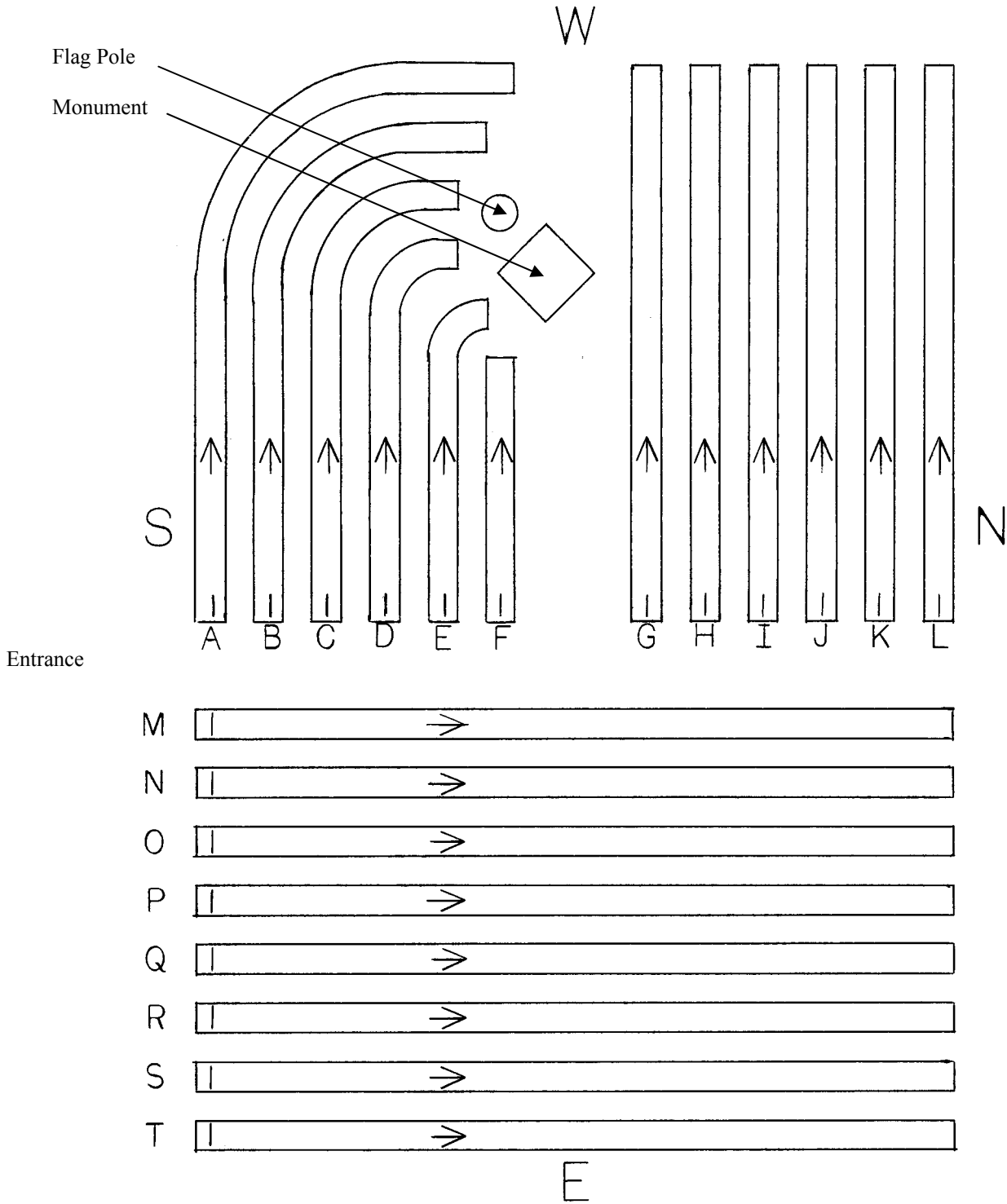

Welcome

The Grand Army of the Republic Cemetery is the only municipal government owned Civil War cemetery in the United States. All other Civil War veteran cemeteries are owned and operated by the Federal Government.

When Grand Army of the Republic veterans and families had run out of money for upkeep of the burial grounds, Seattle City Council acquired this property in stages between 1927 and 1955, and turned its care over to the Seattle Parks Department.

220 grave plots remain to this day and many dedicated volunteers have spent time and energy trying to assist the Seattle Parks Department in maintenance and preservation of this historical treasure.

Currently, the friends and neighbors of Grand Army of the Republic (G.A.R.) cemetery have formed the "Friends of the G.A.R." and are quite active on a monthly basis with dedicated work parties and they meet quarterly for business meetings.

Park Falls Into Disarray

- 1952 Maintenance Concerns

- 1960 Lakeview Cemetery inquires transferring Maintenance to Federal Government - Veterans Administration was only authorized to maintain cemeteries in connection with its own installations. The Department of the Army, Quartermaster General's Office replied that they could not provide funds for maintenance, but by a 1948 law they could furnish appropriate headstones for the unmarked graves of Civil War Veterans.
- 1969 Parks recommends removal of North Hedge, replacement with Hedge 30 yards back
- 1976 City Confirmation that Cemetery Proper Ownership lies with Stevens G.A.R.

Park Adopted by FGAR

- 1996-1997 Park is Designated as Potential Off Leash Dog Run – Veterans Groups and Local Neighbor Protest, Park Must be Adopted if Not a Dog Run.
- 1997 - 2002 Friends of GAR (FGAR) formed – Volunteers Adopt Park. Volunteer Groups plant hundreds of daffodils, formalize headstone rows, clean out and thin hedges, begin staffing a daily flag raising.
- 2002 FGAR Applies for Department of Neighborhood's Small and Simple Grant to Explore Options for Long Term Preservation of GAR Cemetery Park

The GAR Cemetery in Seattle, Washington was platted in 1896. It is located on the north and of Capital Hill in Seattle. The cemetery land is covered with grass, maple and oak trees and is fenced by tall shrubbery, which does not make it easily visible from the street. The cemetery is maintained by the Seattle Parks Department and the Friends of the GAR Cemetery Park.

In the center of the oldest part of the cemetery is a pylon monument, placed by the Woman's Relief Corps. On the face of the monument is the phrase "In memory of our Heroes 1861-1865". On the three remaining sides of the monument at the base are rectangles showing crossed swords, cannons and muskets. There is a flag pole next to the monument.
