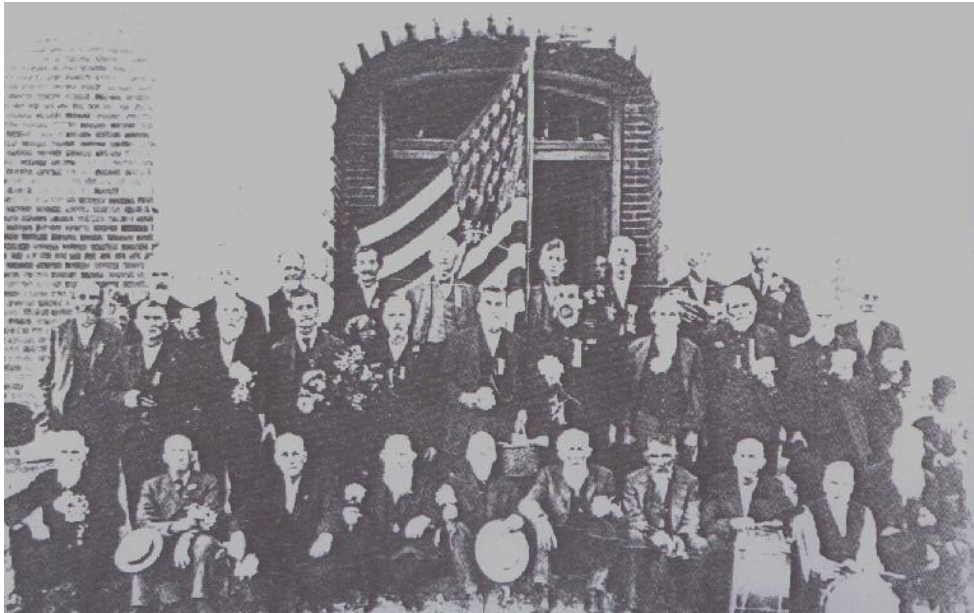


Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War

Spencer, middle row 5th from the left, was a Corporal the 15th Illinois Infantry. He was wounded at the battle of Shiloh. He was captured in 1864 and spent eight months at Andersonville.
