Located at 34∞.00 686' North / 118∞.29 733' West. This is closest to the Santa Monica Pier. The gun appears to be an 8-inch RML. The markings on the barrel are: W. P. F 1886 M.S.Co. 48 No. 48 F.E.H. 16020 lbs. D. A. H. *The concrete pad is inscribed with the date of July 4th 1908, presumably, the date the piece was dedicated.* The carriage is marked "Carriage #18, 3321 Lbs No. 24"



Santa Monica Gun No. 2 - EASTERN VIEW_

Located at $34\infty.00~796$ North / West $118\infty.29~862$ ' Just a few feet north of the Senior Citizens Center. The gun appears to be an 8-inch RML. The markings on the barrel are: W. P. F 1885 M. S. Co. 47 No. 47 F. E. H. 15980 lbs. RB. The concrete pad is not inscribed. The carriage is marked, "*Carriage #2 3321 Lbs.*"
