Enclosed is the CIVIL WAR MEMORIAL ASSESSMENT FORM for the ALL VETERANS MEMORIAL at Evergreen Cemetery, Yreka, Siskiyou County, CA along with two copies. I was not sure if you send the original to National or if you keep it in the Department. I noticed Scholl is on the National Monument Committee and thought he may need a copy. Copies of the cover letter have been distributed, with the packets, to the Cemetery District, Siskiyou County Museum and to John Patchin, as a courtesy so that he knows what has been done in Northern California.

This trip to the Bay Area I have not done any research, just worked on getting my records organized. I finally have one project completed. My "Christmas" gift of a one-year subscription to Ancestors.com is finally available to me so, through their Military records file, I may be able to find solutions to some of the more difficult searches. We shall see!

We leave here Monday, April 9, if not before, and go home to our residence for a week. The following Monday we will head north to Oregon House for Kirby's doctor appointment in Grass Valley the following day. We will be in the rig and should be passing through the Elk Grove area sometime midday. We thought perhaps, if you would be available, we could meet at a restaurant in a shopping mall for a short coordination meeting. We will keep in touch.

We're not sure if we told you that we now have two e-mail addresses. Our PocketMail address (Antendry Market Which is limited to 4000 characters and which we check nearly every day and then which we only check intermittently (when we have a landline available). Scoutmaster Norm Reimers sends the JPG photos and longer messages to the Yahoo address and concurrently sends a note to PocketMail to let us know he has sent something to Yahoo. We keep our cell phone close by most of the time and it is the best way to contact us when we are away from our residence, which has been about 99% of the time so far this year.
