

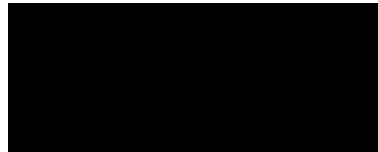

I wish to share a "Success Story" with you of Past National President Michelle Langley From our Auxiliary # 72 in Ovid, New York . New York Auxiliary Department This story was sent to the Banner Editor last October 2010 but was never printed by him.

PNP Michelle Langley worked diligently , collecting money , by projects and donations ( she did not receive a donation from the National Sons.) by determination she gathered over \$7 000 and more . Michelle designed a Civil War Monument , worked with vigor to have the Monument placed in the park in the center of the city of Waterloo, New York in the row of other War Memorial Monuments . she felt very Strongly that there should also be a Civil War Monument. She held many meetings with The City of Officials of Waterloo, NY. To place the Civil War Monument there. Because Waterloo , New York is designated as the birthplace Of Memorial Day after GAR Commander In Chief General Logans proclamation. I want to acknowledge your request for funding for the American Civil War Memorial. It is a worthy project but I have a couple questions.

As I read your request this is a new monument. Is this correct? If it is I can't look at it till 1 May.till June 15. Has a form #61 been filed? If it has and it was completed earlier; then I would if the other two members of the committee agree ask Council to waive this requirement so it could be completed by Memorial Day.
