Monument is in excellent condition. Bronze "Defenders of Freedom" plaques are mounted on the library wall behind the monument.

An "X" has been scratched into the plaque next to "War of 1812" and "World War II" On the upper facade of the building "Gettysburg" is one of twelve battles inscribed. The other battles are mostly from World War 1.

Inside of the Memorial Library is a room dedicated as a war memorial. A large bronze plaque hangs on the north wall "In Memoriam" with the names of Freeport residents who gave their lives during the Civil War, War With Spain, and "The World War" (WWI). The plaque was dedicated on Memorial Day, 1928.

On the south side of the room hangs a plaque of the Gettysburg Address.




