**Overall Description**

Briefly describe the Memorial (affiliation / overall condition & any concern not already touched on) .

The Nassau County Veterans Memorial is a tower. 1971 the county constructed the Veterans Tower dedicated to Nassau County veterans of the Civil War, Spanish-American War, World Wars I and II, Korean and Vietnam Wars. The tower is in the shape of an octagon. Six sides are dedicated to each war. The east and west sides have doors to enter the tower. The north east side is dedicated to the Civil War. With the exception of the east and west side entrances, the six sides have a 6' wide and 9' high red marble facade with the name of the war on top. The Civil War marking, as with the other five wars, is not carved into the marble but put on the marble via decal or paint. The letters seem to be peeling off slightly. Additionally, along with the Korean War side, the Civil War side marble has a slight crack toward the bottom. The tower is constructed from brick and seems to be in good shape.


