A FLAG POLE STAI APPROX. 10' TO THE REAR OF THE GRANITE MARKER. IT COULD USE PAINTING. THERE IS A SANDSTONE BASE IN THE SHAPE OF AN X ABOUT 11' TO THE REAR OF THE FLAG POLE, IT HAS A STACK OF 12PD CANNON BALLS IN THE CENTEI & A PARROTT RIFLE BARREL MOUNTED ON EACH ARM OF THE X.
