

## SILENT SENTRY FUND





For nearly 100 years beginning in 1884, the "Silent Sentry" watched over the graves of Union Veterans at Mount Moriah Cemetery in Philadelphia until being removed from its base in an attempted theft. It was recovered and repaired by the Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States (MOLLUS), who has maintained the monument for decades. Now wishing to return the "Silent Sentry" to its original purpose, MOLLUS has approved its transfer to Laurel Hill, America's first National Historic Landmark cemetery. It will soon be installed at the Grand Army of the Republic (G.A.R.) burial plot of Meade Post #1.

To date, the Friends of Laurel Hill Cemetery has raised over \$25,000 to cover the cost of the monument's rigging and transportation; the purchase and installation of an American Granite base and foundation; the installation and lighting of the monument; and the fabrication of interpretive and donor plaques. Additional funding is now being sought and raised to establish the endowment necessary to ensure the perpetual care of the monument for forthcoming generations. We need your help! All donations are tax-deductible, and those of \$1,000 or more will be acknowledged with a permanent inscription. Donors who contribute at this level will be contacted prior to monument installation regarding how their inscriptions should read. Please provide full contact information below.

The "Silent Sentry" will be rededicated at Laurel Hill's Memorial Day Service in 2014, whereat we will continue to mark the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Civil War. Thank you for helping to ensure that this sacred relic will soon be returned to its proper place of duty guarding the final resting places of the Veterans and the Fallen of America's Civil War.
