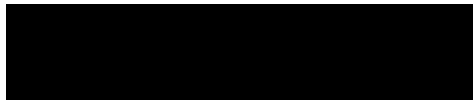

There are 2 howitzers and both have writing on the the rear of the barrel. Both are the same type and model. Both Bronze and made by Ames. Can't read the lettering well enough to determine which is the east cannon and which is the west so the description of both follow.

One howitzer is registration #364 Inspector JAD forged 1864 weight 774; and the other is registration #365 inspector JAF forged 1864 and weight is 775.
