Briefly describe the Memorial (affiliation / overall condition & any concern not already touched on). "In 2005, the remains of Redoubt #3 were inadvertently wiped out by development of a new subdivision by SYG Associates. The developer,
Jimmy Ghaban, said he was shocked when he learned of the fort's destruction and said he would have taken all precautions to preserve
it had he been informed of its existence. (He honors this commitment with ongoing construction at other nearby sites.) To help make amends,
Ghaban erected a \$21,000 monument at the location within the Sentinel Ridge subdivision. The monument is 5½ tons of Vermont granite,
9 feet long by 7 feet high, and topped by a star, the symbol of the Union army's 12th Corps."
