### **E.B. Rogers**

E.B. Rogers was born in Virginia in 1842. On April 27, 1861, he enlisted at Newburg, Virginia in what became Company D of the 3rd West Virginia Volunteer Cavalry, W.W. Averell 4th Separate Division. After the War, he became a resident of Hamilton, Butler County, Ohio. On June 2, 1911, a Butler County Newspaper, *The Daily Republican-News*, published a letter from Rogers in regard to his enlistment and contained two photographs - one taken in 1861 and the other in 1911.
