The main monument is a tall, well crafted and omate concrete pillar decorated with the arms of the services and
topped with a soldier standing at parade rest, holding a musket and wearing a greatcoat and kepi. At the base of
monument mount are four trees. Each tree has a round zinc dedication plaque mounted on a two-piece concrete
wedge. Three of the wedges are marked WRC and the fourth wedge is dedicated by the American Legion.
