Briefly describe the Memorial (affiliation / overall condition & any concern not already touched on). DESCRIPTION: A standing bronze figure of a Civil War Soldier with his right hand resting on the muzzle of a rifle that he holds vertically by his right side.

The figure rests atop a granite base with bronze inscription plaques set in on all four sides.

HISTORY: The figure was sculpted by Martin Milmore, and cast by Ames Manufacturing Company. The plaques were cast by William Blake Company, CONDITION: The bronze base on which the figure stands is severely corroded on the left rear corner, with metallic stains running from the corrosion area

down over the granite base. The front left corner of the stone base has a baseball sized piece broken away. Filling and caulking is

needed on all seams. The bronze plaques show signs of corrosion.
