Last Soldier Ebenezer G. McMurray

Private McMurray (1844-1948) was the last living soldier of Johnson County, Iowa. He was buried in the Sharon Moravian Cemetery in Tuscarawas, Ohio at age 103. This memorial is listed under both Johnson County and Ohio. He served in Company A, 185th Ohio Infantry. The cemetery is located north of town on Moravian Church Road.
