Information on the cannon is from Mr. James Bender who maintains the **National Registry of Known Surviving Civil War Artillery**.

This piece is a 24 pounder flank howitzer, M1844 made by Bellona Foundry, No. 10, manufactured in 1861, with a weight of 1510 pounds. It is believed that this is the last tube made by a Southern foundry for the U.S. Government. The foundry was approximately 10 miles west of Richmond VA.

It was donated to Elliot GAR Post No. 115 on 1/30/1899 and was shipped from Ft. Monroe Arsenal.
