The memorial is fairly new. The mahogany marker was donated by an individual. It was then transported to a monument engraver for the inscription. When it was completed, the monument was set atop a newly poured concrete pad measuring 27" long x 52" wide. Because the stone is triangular in shape if looking at the ends, the inscription on the face of the monument sits at a 45 degree angle allowing the viewers to avoid kneeling to read. The sharp edges were cut off to prevent chipping.
