**"LAST SOLDIER" MARKER DEDICATION FOR JAMES COLUMBUS CLOUSE** On Saturday, May 13, members of Phelps Camp dedicated its first "Last Soldier" marker in Hillcrest Cemetery in Mountain Grove, Missouri.

The marker honors James Columbus Close, the last surviving Union Civil War veteran in Wright County. He died in 1946 at the age of 100. Clouse served in the 5th Tennessee Infantry (U.S.), a regiment that saw action in the Western Theater.
