The seventy-nine bodies buried at Centralia were disinterred December 17, 1873, under direction of Capt. Nelson	_
and forwarded to Jefferson City, and reinterred in the national cemetery at that place. James A. Harris had the contract for taking them up, for which	_
he received \$150. A monument which had been placed over the grave was removed by C.A. Brown for \$30. About fifty-six bodies were taken up the first day. The bones, clothing, cartridge boxes, belts, etc., were well preserved. The skeletons were small, indicating they	_
were of young men. Those who buried them say they were young men, in most cases, with smooth faces and without even mustaches.	-
Seventy-nine skulls were taken out of this grave, each with a bullet hole in it. [NOTE: Some wear on names. All names have been recorded for grave registration as well.]	_
