BATTLE OF PILOT KNOB SEPTEMBER 26-27, 1864

## Text:

A section of Montgomery's Battery, two 3-inch Ordnance Rifles, under Lt. Simonton, helped drive the Rebels back into Shut-In Gap and hold them there until fighting ceased at sunset on the 26th. Early the next morning, Simonton's guns, positioned in front of the courthouse, fired at the attacking Rebels. Rebel cannon responded by firing into Ironton and hitting the courthouse. The two guns that you see here are identical to Simonton's.4
