## Last Soldier James T. Jackson

Corporal James Jackson (1844-1936) was the last living soldier of Hancock County but was buried in Wright County. A native of Ireland, he served in Company D of the 36th Wisconsin Infantry. On October 20, 2017, SUVCW members Danny Krock, Dan Green and Don McGuire honored Corporal Jackson by placing a marker and holding a ceremony at his gravesite.
