Last Soldier Phineas H. Drake

Private Phineas Drake (1843-1944) was the last living soldier of Fremont County. He served in the 11th Illinois Cavalry. While he passed away in Fremont County, he is buried in the Tabor City Cemetery just across the county line in Mills County.
