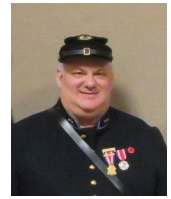

SUVCW. Dale Crandell mustered into Westport Camp #64 on 1 January 2010, to honor his American Civil War ancestor 1st Lieutenant Samuel Crandell of the 6th Kentucky Cavalry. He also documented four supplemental ancestors: Private Lewis Adkins of the 48th Iowa Infantry, Private James Adkins of the 5th Kansas Calvary, Private William Gitt of the 166th Pennsylvania Infantry, and Private Mathew Leonard of the 32nd Missouri Infantry.

SUVCW Camp. Dale Crandell is a Past Camp Commander at Westport Camp #64 in Kansas City; currently serves as Secretary-Treasurer and Grave Registration Officer; and previously served as ROTC Coordinator. He is a dual member of Phelps Camp #66 in Springfield, Missouri. Camp contributions were growing the ROTC program for 5 to 30 schools, developing an annual Medal of Honor commemoration program, securing the camp's state incorporation and sales tax exemption, restoration of the GAR Foot Soldier Monument in Mountain Grove, and approval of a 1916 GAR National Encampment historical marking in Kansas City.

SUVCW Department. Dale Crandell is a Past Department Commander of the Department of Missouri; currently serves as Department Secretary-Treasurer; and previously served as Senior Vice Commander, Junior Vice Commander, Council Member, Patriotic Instructor, and ROTC Coordinator. Department contributions were establishing the JROTC outstanding cadet competition, writing-editing the Policy & Procedures Manual, and establishing visitation between the SUVCW Department Encampment and DUVCW Department Conference.

SUVCW National. Dale Crandell is a graduate of Memorial University and attended eleven National Encampments. National contribution was shepherding supplemental membership starting with a Camp Resolution, passing a supporting Department Resolution, and advocating for its adoption by the National Order.

SVR. Corporal Crandell is Unit Adjutant for the 2nd Missouri Cavalry and dual member of the 1st Missouri Engineers.

Hereditary Organizations. Dale Crandell is President of the Missouri Society of the War of 1812, Treasurer for the MOLLUS Missouri Commandery, and Treasurer for the SAR Josiah Howell Chapter. He is a member of the Sons of the American Revolution, Society of the War of 1812, Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States, Society of the Descendants of the Colonial Clergy, Society of Mayflower Descendants, and Crandall Family Association.
