Gettysburg Boulder Monument

This is an actual boulder brought from Gettysburg. It is granite about 5 1/2 feet high, 4 1/2 feet wide and 3 feet deep. There is a plaque showing it was dedicated by the WRC in 1916. Originally there were four mountain howitzers on the corners of the monument but they are now located at the Lisbon History Center. The cemetery is in the SE part of town.
