Marble monument 11feet in height - In very good condition. Cemetery is well maintained.  
Foundation is concrete and painted white - 8 inches in height and 38 w x 38 in dia - paint is flaking off  
Base in concrete and painted white -25 inches in height and 28.25 inches wide x 28.25 in diameter - tapers up with top at 26 inches wide.. Paint is flaking off  
Plinth is gray marble and south face with inscription says: 1861-1865 - 10 inches in height and 20 1/8 inch W x 20 1/8 inch Diameter.  
Obelisk is gray marble and south facing inscription says: To The Memory of Our Heroic Dead - emblem of crossed scabbards below it and GAR badge is above it. The obelisk is 87 inches in height and 14 inches wide at lower base and tapering up to 10 inches at the cap.
