Revocation of Bay State Camp 61, Department of Massachusetts

Department Commander Roderick J. Fraser, Jr. of the Department of Massachusetts has requested that the Charter of Bay State Camp 61 be revoked.

According to a communication from Camp 61 Commander Mark Lewis, the Camp held a meeting on September 5, 2025, and those present voted to close the Camp and turn in their Camp Charter. (Regulations, Chapter I, Article I, Section 4)

The Department Commander has provided a detailed report to the Commander-in-Chief concerning these actions, and all property and money in the Camp treasury has been transmitted to the Department of Massachusetts Commander, acting as the representative of the Commander-in-Chief to collect and hold all such property in trust for the National Organization, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, an organization exempt from taxes under section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code. (Regulations, Chapter I, Article I, Section 5).

Revocation of the Charter for Bay State Camp 61 is hereby ordered this 22nd Day of September, 2025.
