The plaza has 7 black granite polished monolith panels that line the courtyard. The second and third panel from the north have Civil War references inscribed. 6 of the panels are 66 1/2 inch in height and 4ft 2 in in width. The edges are rusticated.
Inscription on the 2nd panel: HONOR ROLL - REVOLUTIONARY WAR - JEREMIAH GRAVES --- WAR OF 1812 - MEXICAN WAR -- CIVIL WAR WITH 78 VETERANS NAMES engraved --
The inscription on the 3rd panel is a continuation of 58 Civil War Veteran names engraved -- followed by 11 veterans of the Spanish American War and World War I veterans listed that extend to the back of the monument and the 4th front and back as well.
The center black polished granite panel lays horizontally and is 6 feet long and 45 1/2 inches in width and 6 inches in depth. The top is polished. The sides are rusticated. It is engraved with the inscription: FREEDOM IS NOT FREE - there is a flying eagle holding arrows and shield that is etched in the top center. 5 circular emblems with the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines with an inscription below it the reads: IN HONOE OF THOSE WHO SERVED OUR COUNTY IN TIME OF WAR AND PEACE. -- OKLAHOMA TERRITORIAL PLAZE -DEDICATED NOVEMBER 11, 20014
The courtyard has a flag pole and 6 granite benches that surround the plaza.
