FIVE PANEL GRAY GRANITE CENTER PANEL IS 8 FEET BY 3FT - FLANKED BY MIDDLE PANELS 7.5FT HEIGHT BY 3 FT IN WIDTH --OUTER FLANKING PANELS 42.5INCHES HEIGHT BY 31 INCHES IN WIDTH - WITH THE AMERICAN LEGION AND VFW PANELS MEASURING 36 INCHES BY 37 INCHES -- EACH EMBLEM IS ENGRAVED AND PAINTED. THE FIVE PANELS ARE JOINED TOGETHER WITH A 18.5 FOOT GRANITE BASE 18.5 INCHES THICK. ENGRAVED ON BOTH SIDES: IN MEMORY OF THE VETERANS OF OUR BELOVED AMERICA. MARLOW OKLAHOMA. -- THE TOP CENTER PANEL HAS A PAINTED AMERICAN FLAG AND ENSCRIBED: GIVE ME LIBERTY OR GIVE ME DEATH -- PATRICK HENRY. WITH THE WEST FACING SIDE: CIVIL WAR AND THREE COLUMNS OF 64 NAMED CIVIL WAR SOLDIERS. -- THE EAST FACING SIDE HAS WWI & WWII AND KOREAN WAR NAMES CONTINUED. THE MONUMENT IS HOUSED UNDER AN ALUMINUM SHELTER WITH A CONCRETE RAISED FLOOR.
