**General Order No. 14**

**Administrative Access to Department and Camp Digital Assets**

1. On the advice of the National Signals Officer, the Commander-in-Chief has determined that the continuity, security, and proper administration of Department and Camp digital communications are essential to the effective operation and public presence of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War.
2. It has come to attention that, in some instances, access to Department and Camp websites, Facebook pages, YouTube channels and other social media platforms is held by a single individual. This presents a risk to operational continuity in the event of illness, resignation, incapacity, or other unforeseen circumstances.
3. Therefore, it is hereby ordered that each Department and each Camp shall ensure that no fewer than two (2) Brothers hold full administrative access to all official digital assets, including but not limited to:
  - Websites and domain registrations
  - Facebook pages and groups
  - Other social media accounts (e.g., X/Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, etc.)
  - Any third-party platforms used for communication or member engagement
4. These designated administrators shall be Members in good standing. Wherever practicable, at least one of the administrators should be an elected Officer of the Department or Camp. **These designees are not required to be skilled webmasters, but must maintain possession of all hosting URL's, (links) account logins and passwords.**
5. Departments shall ensure that subordinate Camps within their jurisdiction are informed of and comply with this Order.
6. Departments and Camps are further encouraged to:
  - Maintain secure records of account credentials in accordance with best practices
  - Promptly update administrative access when leadership changes occur
  - Periodically verify that access permissions remain current and functional

7. Compliance with this Order shall be reviewed by Department and Camp leadership and implemented without delay. Department Commanders shall report compliance status at the next regularly scheduled reporting period or as otherwise directed.
8. This Order is issued to safeguard the institutional continuity and public mission of our Order and shall remain in effect until amended or rescinded.
