Announcement of the SUVCW Commemorative Henry “1860 SUV Eagle®” Partnership Project

To the Officers and Brothers of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War,

As our Nation commemorates the 250th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, we are called once more to reflect upon the sacrifices made to preserve the American Republic and the enduring principles of Liberty and Union for which the soldiers of the United States Army fought during the Civil War.

In that spirit, the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War is pleased to announce a commemorative partnership project undertaken through the efforts of the National Special Committee on Fundraising in cooperation with Henry Repeating Arms of Rice Lake, Wisconsin. Together, this effort seeks to honor the memory and service of the Union soldier while supporting the educational, memorial, and patriotic work of our Order.

The project centers upon the limited-edition Henry “1860 SUV Eagle®” rifle, inspired by the historic Henry repeating rifle first patented in 1860 by Benjamin Tyler Henry. The original Henry rifle earned distinction during the Civil War era for its innovative design and became closely associated with the courage and determination of Union troops who carried it into service in defense of the Nation.

This commemorative edition has been thoughtfully designed to reflect that history and the heritage of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War. Elements incorporated into the rifle recognize the service and sacrifice of the “Boys in Blue,” the preservation of the Union, and the principles long upheld by our Order: Fraternity, Charity, and Loyalty.

The Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War does not generally endorse commercial products or enterprises. However, the National Organization recognizes this commemorative project as an officially approved fundraising initiative intended to support the charitable, educational, memorial, and historical preservation activities of the Order. Proceeds received through this program will assist the SUVCW in continuing its mission of honoring the memory of the Grand Army of the Republic and preserving the history and legacy of the Union veteran.

Information regarding ordering procedures, availability, and member participation is being distributed separately through the National Special Committee on Fundraising and official

organizational channels. Brothers interested in obtaining additional information are encouraged to consult those materials.

On behalf of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, I extend sincere appreciation to Henry Repeating Arms and all those whose efforts helped bring this commemorative undertaking to fruition in support of the Good of the Order and in remembrance of the Union soldier.
