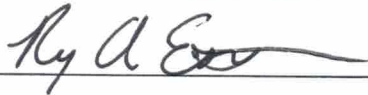

We have secured the support of the City of Ormond Beach, obtained donations from American Legion Post #267, are soliciting funds from other patriotic & veteran groups, & will finalize

estimates, have project brought to public attention via news & SM.

Adelbert Ames, born October 31, 1835 at Rockland, Maine, died on April 13, 1933 at Ormond Beach, Florida as the last surviving full-rank general of the Civil War. Over the course of his life he earned many accolades including graduating 5th from West Point in May 1861 at age 26, earning the Medal of Honor for gallantry at First Bull Run, achieving the rank of Brevet Major General for the capture of Fort Fisher in 1865 when he was 29, serving as the governor and Senator from Mississippi, and taking command again during the Spanish-American War during the Siege of Santiago at age 63. Despite this incredible legacy, there is no monument to General Ames anywhere.

The Department of Florida, SUVCW and Camp #9 John A Logan have undertaken this project to honor Ames at the place of his death at Ames Park, Ormond Beach, Florida. Our project consists of two parts: firstly, a state historical marker that has already been fully funded by American Legion Post #267 and an actual monument with his likeness. Our plan is 2 18x24 bronze plaques mounted on a granite stone: one plaque on the front with his likeness and another plaque with a list of our supporters. The current estimated cost for the monument is under \$11,000 - \$4500 for the plaques, and an estimated \$5500 for the installation of the granite. We are in talks with the City of Ormond Beach, Daughters of the American Revolution, Sons of the American Revolution, Vietnam Veterans of America, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and other Departments of the SUVCW to help secure additional funding.

Adelbert Ames was a proud member of the Grand Army of the Republic and the Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States. The lack of recognition in his life is a historical tragedy that we hope to rectify with the support of this grant. This grant would bring us one step closer to honoring the legacy of General Ames who gave so much to his country but is yet to be honored with a monument.

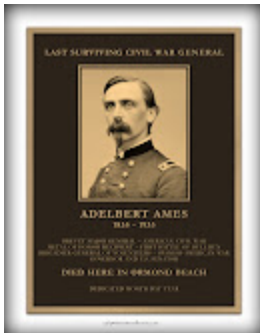

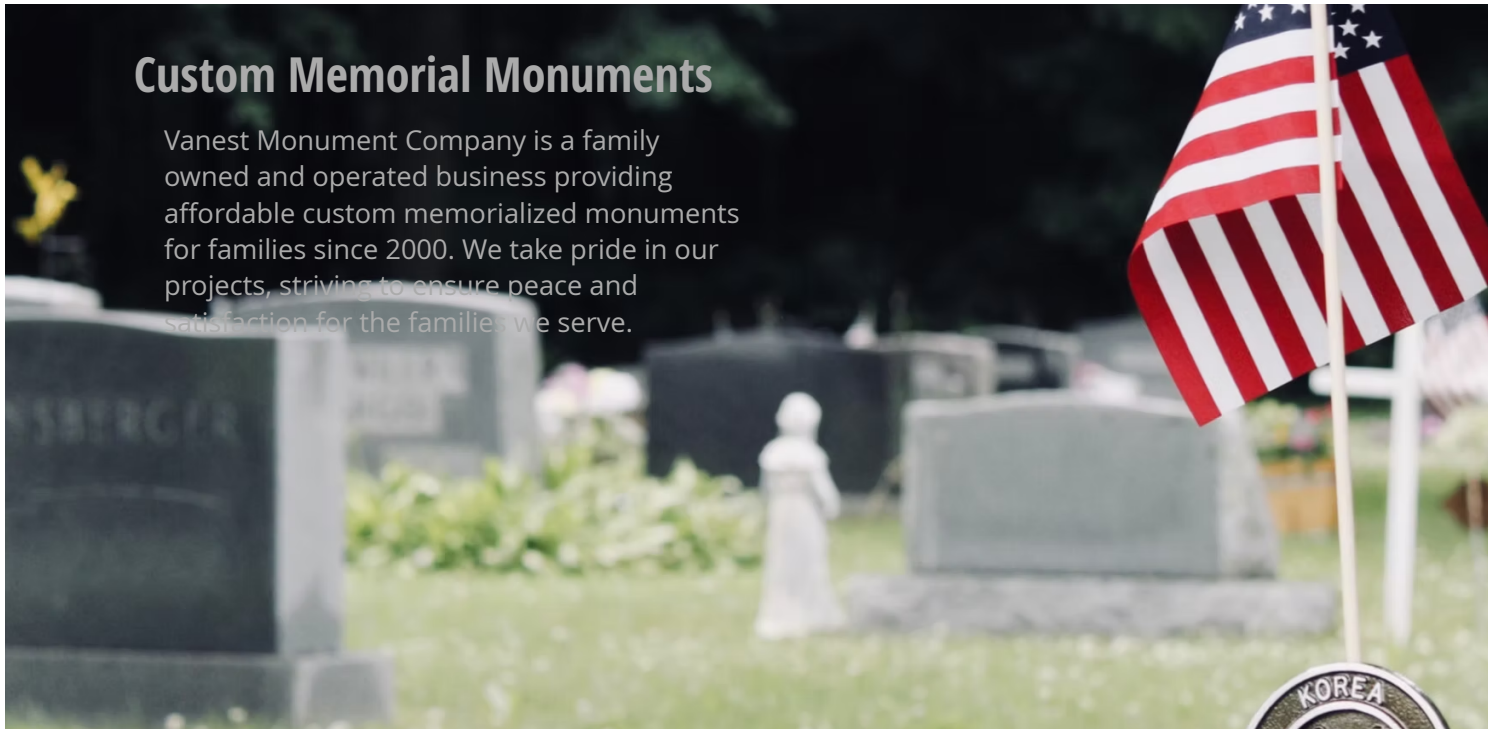

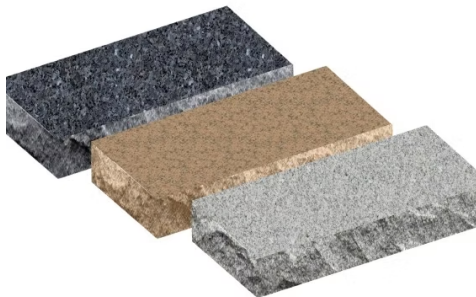

Monument Styles

Flat/Grassmarker

A Grass Monument sits flush with the ground. Ground maintenance is generally easier with a flat marker which allows lawnmowers to pass over without touching the stone.



Standard measurements are:

Single - 24in. long x 12in. wide x 4in. thick

Double - 48in. long x 12in. wide x 4in. thick.

*Some cemeteries only allow flat markers please check with cemetery to determine.

Bevel/Hickey

A Bevel Monument or Hickey sits flat on the ground but not flush. It measures 6in. tall in the back of the stone and 4in. tall in the front of the stone, giving the face a 2 inch drop or beveled top.

Standard measurements are:

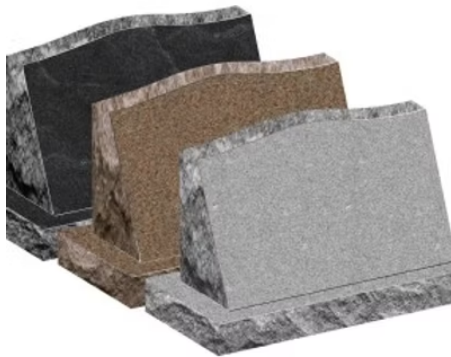
Single - 24in. long x 12in. wide x 6in. tall

Double - 48in. long x 12in. wide x 6in. tall

*These are standard sizes but can be made larger or smaller.

Slant

A Slant Monument has a straight back and a flat bottom with a slanted face. The bottom is typically 10in. wide from front to back and tapers up to the top. This means the monument can be set directly on the ground or on a concrete pad without needing a granite base for support. Some prefer the base option to elevate the monument for added height.

Standard Measurements are:

Single - 24in. long x 10in. wide x 16in. tall

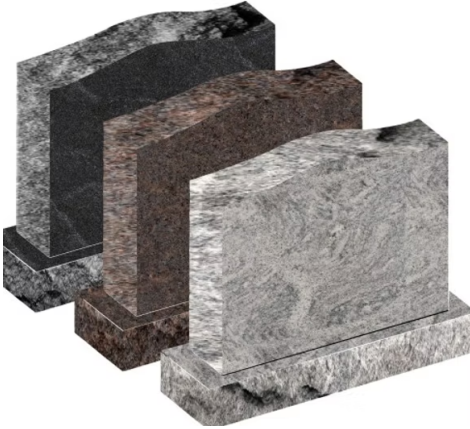
Double - 48in. long x 10in. wide x 16in. tall

*These are standard sizes but can be made larger or smaller.

Upright



Upright Monuments have a wide variety of shapes, sizes, and finishes. Being the most popular of memorials, the die (upright portion) can range from 6in. - 12in. in thickness.

Standard measurements are:

Single - 24in. long x 6in. wide x 20-24in. tall

Base: 36in. long x 12in. wide x 6in. tall

Double - 42-48in. long x 6-12in. wide x 20-24in. tall

Base: up to 60in. long

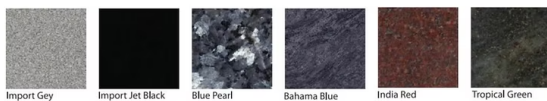

DOMESTIC GRANITES

These are quarried in the US from Eagle owned quarries - as well as out of state quarries - to offer as many choices as possible. Each color has its own unique variegation, color and qualities that makes each one unique. These colors are manufactured in our Elberton plant and generally take 4 to 6 weeks for delivery.

Granite Colors

Each granite color has its own unique variegation, color and qualities that makes each one unique and different from the last.

Sandblasting

A sandblasted design general starts with a rubberized mask or template, outlining the design and then sandblasting exposes the surface of the granite to create difference in color and texture. Sandblast designs are the most requested carvings, especially on flat or smaller monuments.

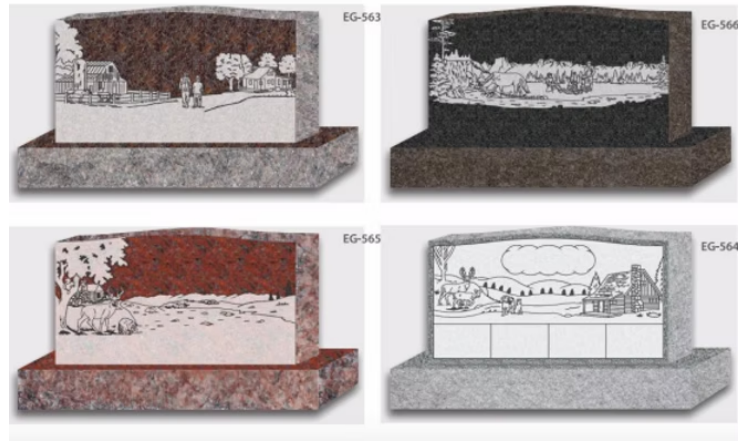

Hand or Lazer Etching

Hand etchings are created using diamond tipped engraving tools to draw or etch directly onto a polished monument. An etching looks best on polished black granite because this will give the greatest contrast. Etchings can also be done with a laser. Either type of etching can be hand colored after the initial design is completed.
