TEXT

This memorial is located inside Sutton Town Hall in Sutton, Massachusetts. The memorial consists of multiple marble panels with carved reliefs and inscriptions commemorating Sutton citizens who served during the Civil War. The central inscription reads, "Erected by the Town of Sutton in honor of her sons who served in the War of the Rebellion." The memorial remains in excellent condition and continues to occupy a place of honor within the town's principal municipal building. Attached photographs document the memorial and its inscriptions.
